Connecting Teachers in a Physically-Distant World



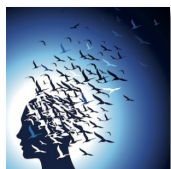

**Nadene Klein** (DC Oaks High School) will

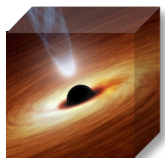


lead a workshop on
